If staying in a campground and walking to the golf course sounds like your “cup of tea”, then look at this opportunity to be a Campground Host at Fisher Grove State Park! Surrounded by the flowing James River, and it is where the first crossing was for the Watertown-to-Pierre stage line. This stage line originally crossed over the American Indians’ traditional rock river crossing, which was a natural “bridge”. The park is located 8.5 miles east of Redfield and was where the first post office in the county was established in 1879. There are 22 campsites, a shower house, fishing areas, and the campground is located within walking distance of a 10-hole golf course.
