

GFP SEEKING COMMENTS ON CURRENT WILD TURKEY MANAGEMENT PLAN

PIERRE, S.D. - The South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks (GFP) is seeking comments on the 2001-2010 wild turkey management plan prior to drafting a five-year plan for 2015-2019.
