Spring Nature Hike

Learn the basics of what it takes to fish in SD and how to do it safely. We'll talk about basic equipment, safety, and ethics before heading out to the pond and dropping in a line.

Learn all about the basics of safely operating a BB gun and spend the rest of the time on our range practicing. (Younger children may attend with parent/guardian assistance)

We will start the morning fishing, and with some luck we will end the morning learning how to clean our catch and also how to cook it for lunch.

This class will be ongoing throughout the Fall and will be a bit of a time commitment with early mornings and late evenings. The goal of this class is to introduce and/or make students/ families more comfortable hunting in hopes of building a lifelong passion of hunting.
