CandleLight Walk

Newton Hills State Park

Saturday, October 4, 2025 from 7:30 - 9 pm

Enjoy a self-guided candlelit journey through the deep woods of Newton Hills. The trail will be solely lit up by candles and carved pumpkins. People may begin walking the approximate 1 hour hike anytime between 7:30 —9pm. We ask you not use your flashlight unless absolutely necessary and keep your voices to a minimum. Dogs on the hike are not recommended. Take as long as you wish and enjoy the wonders of nature!

ADVISORY: The walk is approximately 2.2 miles in length traveling on paved roads with vertical declines and inclines so please be prepared. If you need assistance during the walk, park employees will be scattered along the trail tending to the candles. One hill along the back stretch of the trail is rather steep, so park employees will be nearby with a golf cart dressed in glow sticks if you need help getting up the hill.
