Snake Creek park district includes Snake Creek Recreation Area, Platte Creek Recreation Area, and Buryanek Recreation Area. The park district has around 250 campsites, cabins, and features multiple boat ramps, day-use areas, and water-based recreation. Lake Francis Case offers some of the best walleye and smallmouth bass fishing in the state, and the area includes great hunting, including deer, waterfowl, turkey, and more. The work view is pretty great, too!

Like an oasis on the prairie, Burke Lake Recreation Area sits next to a 25-acre lake which is surrounded by trees. Whether boating, kayaking or canoeing, visitors enjoy this lake that averages only eight feet in depth. Native and introduced prairie grasses and wildflowers abound in the 206-acre park, and wildlife of all kinds inhabit this unique area.
