- The Summer Trail Challenge consists of the eight trails listed above and is open from May 1 to Sept. 6, 2021
- Pick up an official Trail Challenge form from the Visitor Center or Park Office. (*NOTE: AN OFFICIAL FORM MUST BE USED*)
- At one point along each trail is a bronze rubbing medallion installed near a post with a Trail Challenge Sign. To complete the Trail Challenge, participants must hike all the listed trails and collect a rubbing at a Trail Challenge rubbing medallion on the official form.
- We ask that completed forms with rubbings be mailed to the address to the left. All completed forms must be submitted by Monday, Sept. 13, 2021.
- Please take only one form per family.
- We encourage you to take advantage of getting out on a Trail, however remember to follow the CDC's social distancing guidelines.
