

Important Lodge Information!!

- Check out time is 11:00 AM, Check in is 4:00 PM
- ➤ No smoking allowed in the lodge
- ▶ Pets are not permitted anywhere in the lodge (other than service animals). A kennel has been provided outside to hold pets. A minimum \$50 cleaning fee will be charged to your credit card if there are pets in the building.
- > Park entrance license is required on every vehicle, whether staying at or visiting the lodge.
- Cost:
 - Lodge cost to rent the lodge is \$185 + tax per night (\$195.18) for the first 8 persons, plus \$10 for each additional person with a maximum occupancy of 10 persons.
 - RV Site (L1) One camping unit is permitted at the adjoining campsite by the lodge for an additional \$19 + tax/night. Maximum of 6 persons or 1 family.
 - o Additional Tents or Campers Additional tents or campers are not allowed.
- > **Supplies:** If there is need for additional paper towels, toilet paper, garbage bags, propane, or other supplies please contact staff at the Mina Booth or Park Office.
- ➤ **Cleaning:** Please clean the Lodge before your departure. Any major spills or messes are the responsibility of the renter to clean up.
 - O Dishes should be washed, dried, and put back in the cupboards and drawers where you found them. Do not leave dirty dishes.
 - Clean up any messes in the microwave, fridge and stove. Remove all trash from the Lodge and place in the dumpster provided.
 - o Please leave any dish towels and rags that were used on the counter.
 - o A mop and vacuum can be found in the master bedroom closet, along with extra folding chairs and table. A broom and dust pan can be found in the kitchen by the fridge.
 - You will be charged for any damage or excessive messes left in the Lodge.
- > Turn off lights and air conditioner or fire place before leaving to help conserve energy.
- ➤ Please report any needed repairs, safety hazards, or suggestions to the Mina Lake staff by note, phone, or in person.
