

Our vision is to conserve our state's outdoor heritage to enhance the quality of life for current and future generations.








What is Environmental Review?

National Environmental Policy Act



- NEPA requires federal agencies to assess the environmental effects of a proposed actions prior to making decisions
- Any time a project has federal funding
- Projects that involve federal land
- Projects that require a federal permit







Environmental Concerns in South Dakota




Species of Concern
