Scope of this Addendum:

The following becomes a part of the original plans and specifications, taking precedence over the items that may conflict. The bidder shall note receipt and make acknowledgment of the addendum on his bid form, incorporating its provisions in his bid.

**Item No. 1:** Reference Plan Sheet Page 4, **Asphalt Surface Treatment - 1.8 Mile Reconstruct**. Change to the following:

**ASPHALT SURFACE TREATMENT - 1.8 MILE RECONSTRUCT**

The 1.8 Mile Playhouse Road Reconstruct shall receive a double Asphalt Surface Treatment following the prime application. The AST shall be done in accordance with the SDDOT Standard Specifications Section 360.

First AST application -

Asphalt shall conform to SDDOT Standard Specifications for **AE150S** and shall be applied at the rate of 0.40 Gal/SY, or as directed by the Engineer.

Cover aggregate for the Asphalt Surface Treatment shall conform to the SDDOT Standard Specifications for **Type 2A** cover aggregate and shall be applied at a rate of 32 lbs./SY or as directed by the Engineer in the field.

Second AST application -

Asphalt shall conform to SDDOT Standard Specifications for **AE150S** and shall be applied at the rate of 0.35 Gal/SY, or as directed by the Engineer.

Cover aggregate for the Asphalt Surface Treatment shall conform to the SDDOT Standard Specifications for **Type 2A** cover aggregate and shall be applied at a rate of 26 lbs./SY or as directed by the Engineer in the field.

Invoice weigh tickets shall be provided by the Contractor to confirm established quantities delivered to the project site and to allow the Engineer to calculate the spread rate during the Asphalt Surface Treatment application.

**Item No. 2:** Reference attached Revised Bid Form and Revised Bid Modification Forms.

These forms replace previous forms. Bidders are to submit bids and modifications using the attached revised forms.

**Item No. 3:** Additional Items:

Water for compaction may be sourced from Center Lake provided the Contractor obtains a Temporary Use Permit from South Dakota Department of Agriculture and Natural Resources (DANR). Access may be coordinated with Custer State Park Staff.

The above bid includes all applicable State and Municipal Sales and Use Taxes on materials, and State and Municipal Excise Taxes and all other State and Federal Taxes that would affect the amount of the bid. (See Instructions to Bidders-SD Sales and Use Tax Information for Public Contracts.)

In addition, any material furnished by the State for use in this project is subject to Use Tax and Excise Tax. The total taxable value of materials furnished by the State for this project is **\$0.00**.

*A Performance and Payment Bond as required by General Conditions will not be required on contracts which do not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000). (See SDCL 5-21-1.1 as amended).*

*If discrepancies remain at the time of substantial completion, a value will be assigned to each of the discrepancies and two (2) times their estimated value will be retained from payment to the contractor until completed and accepted. (See SDCL 5-18-13 as amended).*

**Within ten (10) days after Contractor's receipt of the Agreement for Construction, the Contractor shall submit to the Game, Fish and Parks Engineering Section, the executed Agreement for Construction, Performance and Payment Bond, Certificates of Insurance and Affirmative Action Plan (if applicable).**

**Work shall be commenced within ten (10) consecutive calendar days after written Notice to Proceed by the SD Game, Fish and Parks and shall be substantially completed by September 16, 2022.**

In submitting this bid, bidder asserts it has reviewed all provisions of the General Conditions including the provision for assessment of liquidated delay damages found in Article 10 of the General Conditions. Bidder agrees that the damages anticipated by the Owner in the event of delay in completion of the project are uncertain in amount and difficult to prove; the amount stipulated in Article III of the Agreement for Construction is a reasonable amount in light of the anticipated loss and injury; and the Owner's actual damages in the event of delay would be impracticable or extremely difficult to fix. Bidder agrees to be bound by the liquidated damages set forth in Article III of the Agreement for Construction. Bidder further agrees that the liquidated amount stipulated in Article III of the Agreement for Construction is not a penalty.
