Scope of this Addendum:

The following becomes a part of the original plans and specifications, taking precedence over the items that may conflict. The bidder shall note receipt and make acknowledgment of the addendum on his bid form, incorporating its provisions in his bid.

## 1. Bid Item 1.01 Limestone Ledge Rock, Furnish & Install shall conform to the following plan note/specification:

Limestone Ledge Rock shall be furnished by the Contractor and conform to the requirements of SDDOT Standard Specifications Section 882. Limestone Ledge Rock shall come from a previously permitted commercial pit.

Construction requirements for Limestone Ledge Rock shall conform to the SDDOT Standard Specifications Section 260. Limestone Ledge Rock shall be placed and compacted so that plan thicknesses are met on the various road and parking lots. The width and limits of miscellaneous areas may be adjusted in the field by the Engineer as necessary.

The Limestone Ledge Rock shall conform to the following gradation requirements (SDDOT Standard Specifications Section 882, Table 1):



Invoice weigh tickets shall be provided by the Contractor to confirm established quantities delivered to the project site. Field measurements will also be used to determine adequate application rates. A conversion factor of 1.48 tons/CY and a compaction factor of 1.3 were used in determining the Estimate of Quantities.

All costs incurred for weighing, hauling, stockpiling, spreading, watering and compaction including all labor, equipment, materials and incidentals necessary to complete the work, shall be included in the contract unit price bid for "Limestone Ledge Rock, F&I."

The Contractor shall provide the Engineer with pit production test results for the material to be used and a minimum 100 lb. sample of the material for testing at the Pre-Construction meeting to verify initial quality assurance.

The above unit prices shall include all labor, materials, bailing, shoring removal, overhead, profit, insurance, etc., to cover the finished work of the several kinds called for. Changes shall be processed in accordance with Article 14 of the General Conditions.

The Owner also reserves the unrestricted privilege to reject any unit prices for additions to or deductions from the scheduled amount of work as given in the Bid, if the same are considered excessive or unreasonable, or to accept by including the same in the contract as unit prices applicable in the event of addition to or deduction from the work to be performed under the contract, any or all such unit prices which may be considered fair or reasonable.

The above bid includes all applicable State and Municipal Sales and Use Taxes on materials, and State and Municipal Excise Taxes and all other State and Federal Taxes that would affect the amount of the bid. (See Instructions to Bidders-SD Sales and Use Tax Information for Public Contracts.)

In addition, any material furnished by the State for use in this project is subject to Use Tax and Excise Tax. The total taxable value of materials furnished by the State for this project is \$0.00.

A Performance and Payment Bond as required by General Conditions will not be required on contracts which do not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000). (See SDCL 5-21-1.1 as amended).

If discrepancies remain at the time of substantial completion, a value will be assigned to each of the discrepancies and two (2) times their estimated value will be retained from payment to the contractor until completed and accepted. (See SDCL 5-18-13 as amended).

Within ten (10) days after Contractor's receipt of the Agreement for Construction, the Contractor shall submit to the Game, Fish and Parks Engineering Section, the executed Agreement for Construction, Performance and Payment Bond, Certificates of Insurance and Affirmative Action Plan (if applicable).

Work shall be commenced within ten (10) consecutive calendar days after written Notice to Proceed by the SD Game, Fish and Parks and shall be substantially completed by December 19, 2025.

Bidder agrees to be bound by the liquidated damages set forth in Article III of the Agreement for Construction. Bidder further agrees that the liquidated amount stipulated in Article III of the Agreement for Construction is not a penalty.
