

Coyote Access Permit for Custer State Park

The issuance of these free access permits will allow South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks to collect improved hunter use and harvest data within Custer State Park.

Open Area: Custer State Park

Season Dates: December 26, 2018 – March 31, 2019

There is an unlimited number of Access Permits for this season.

The permit may be obtained anytime throughout the season and must be printed off at home. Please be sure to read the instructions during the application process to learn how to print your Custer State Park Coyote Access Permit off at home.

The following criteria and rules will apply to hunting within Custer State Park where an Access Permit is required.

- A person must have purchased a resident predator/varmint license, resident furbearer license, or any resident hunting license before applying for the Access Permit.
- A person must have their applicable License and Access Permit with them while hunting.
- No hunting allowed within 200 yards of any public access road or building in Custer State Park.
- Access Permit holders are responsible for leaving the property they are hunting in the same condition as they found it.
- A person's Access Permit will be revoked if the hunter is found to be in violation of any of these rules.
