## **SPRING ARCHERY TURKEY**

There were 4,276 resident and 676 nonresident licenses sold for a total of 4,952 licensed spring archery turkey hunters in 2023.

Surveys were sent via email invitations to respond online. All license holders that provided a valid email address were surveyed, and the response rate was 45%.

The projected harvest based on survey responses was 1,247 male turkeys. The harvest success rate was 25%. The season was open from April 8 through May 31 and the projected total number of days hunted was 16,158, an average of 3.26 days per hunter.

The five units with the highest reported harvest were Gregory, Black Hills, Day/Codington, Marshall/Roberts, and Yankton.
