



## Hike and Seek Rules Creatures of the Night, Oct. 2020

### To Enter:

- Visit [www.gfp.sd.gov/hike-and-seek](http://www.gfp.sd.gov/hike-and-seek) to find a participating location.
- Take a selfie with the Hike and Seek rules sign for that location. The sign is found at the beginning of each participating trail.
- Visitors will come across five more signs along the path with information about nocturnal creatures in South Dakota. Each will have a smaller, secondary sign hidden nearby (within viewing distance) featuring a graphic of the animal featured on the sign.
- Find all five animal signs and keep track of the code word from each.
- Submit the selfie photo and five code words to [parkinfo@state.sd.us](mailto:parkinfo@state.sd.us) to enter. Be sure to include your name, mailing address and participating location (if not visible in the selfie). Submissions will receive an email reply to confirm entry.

### Hike and Seek Rules:

- The hike and seek is sponsored by the South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks. It is open to all ages during park operating hours (though after dark might be more fun).
- The contest runs throughout October 2020. Entries must be submitted on or before Nov. 1, 2020. The activity may remain available beyond the contest end date in some locations.
- Vehicles must have a valid park entrance license if required at the park.
- One entry per person per participating location.
  - Families are allowed to enter together if a photo is received. The submitting email address will be entered once for each person in the selfie photo. If no selfie is received, the email will be entered in once.
- One winning email address will be randomly selected from all entries for each location by Nov. 9. Winners will be notified via email from [parkinfo@state.sd.us](mailto:parkinfo@state.sd.us) and their prize mailed to the address provided. If a mailing address cannot be obtained within a week, a new winner will be selected.
- By submitting your photo(s), you are giving the SDGFP the right to:
  - Add your email address to their electronic mailing list. The ability to easily opt-out is available on every email.
  - Use the photo(s) on their social platforms, publications and other areas both print and electronic.
