

## Disabled Veteran and Prisoner of War Lifetime State Park Entrance License Application

---

Any South Dakota resident who meets one of the following criteria may apply for a free lifetime park entrance license valid at any South Dakota state park or recreation area.

- A veterans allotment for a total disability which is deemed a service-connected injury
- The United States Veterans Administration "K" Award
- Was held as a prisoner of war

**Eligibility:** You must be a resident of South Dakota. Along with this completed application form, you must submit a copy of the "K" award or letter from the Veteran's Administration indicating you receive a veteran's allotment for 100% total disability which is deemed a service connected injury or that you were held as a prisoner of war, which will meet eligibility as established in state law SDCL 41-17-13.4.

If you do not have these papers in your possession you may contact the Veteran's Administration office in Sioux Falls and have them sent to you or you may request in writing that the Veteran's Administration mail a copy of these papers to the Department Of Game, Fish, and Parks.

Approved applicants will receive a billfold lifetime park entrance license. The card also allows the permit holder a 50% discount on any camping fee or associated electrical service fee for their site.
