DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDATION

Season Dates:

December 26, 2013 – March 1, 2014

December 26, 2013 – January 19, 2014

Area:

All counties west of the Missouri River.

Buffalo, Brule, Charles Mix, Bon Homme, and Yankton counties.

Requirements and Restrictions:

1. Trappers or hunters who participate in the bobcat season east river are limited to one bobcat per trapper or hunter.
2. A bobcat taken must be presented to a conservation officer or wildlife damage specialist for registration and tagging of the pelt within 5 days of harvest. Additionally, once the season has closed, an individual has 24 hours to notify a conservation officer or wildlife damage specialist of any untagged bobcats harvested during the season. The pelt must be removed from the carcass and the carcass must be surrendered to the conservation officer or wildlife damage specialist. After the pelt has been tagged, it shall be returned to the hunter or trapper. Upon request, the carcass may be returned to the hunter or trapper after the carcass has been inspected and the lower jaw has been removed. A person may only possess, purchase or sell raw bobcat pelts that are tagged through the eyeholes with the tag provided by the department.

Recommended changes from last year:

1. The west river season will open at sunrise on December 26 and close at sunset on March 1 or if a total harvest of 600 bobcats is reached prior to March 1.
2. Change the east river season to open at sunrise on December 26 and close at sunset on the third Sunday of January.


SUPPORTIVE INFORMATION

The last three consecutive years of the west river bobcat season has experienced sex ratios that have been skewed towards a higher ratio of females being harvested. Having more females than males harvested is an indicator of a moderate or heavy harvested population.


The average harvest for the past 11 years is 647 bobcats for the west river season.

WR Bobcat - Male / Female Ratio




Statewide Bobcat Harvest
