Downloading Application and Map

ArcGIS Field Maps is a free to use, offline capable map replacing Avenza Maps. If you do not have Field Maps downloaded on your mobile device, **selecting the link or scanning the QR code** below will take you to the download page for the application. An account is not required. **Skip sign in** to continue.

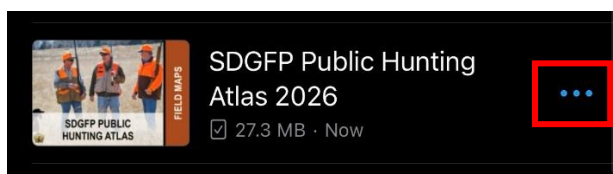
Once the application is installed. Either use the **search** function in the application by typing “SDGFP Public Hunting Atlas” or **clicking the link or scanning the QR code** below to download the map.

Using Maps

On your Maps home screen, you will see all currently downloaded maps. To **View Details**, **Check For Updates**, or **Remove Downloaded** maps, select the overflow menu (...). If an update is available, the map will be updated once the **Check For Download** option is selected.



When opening maps, be sure to **allow access to device location** to use location services and tracking.

Map Units

ArcGIS Field Maps allows you to use measurement tools. Currently, there is not a way for the publisher of a map to set the measurement units. To customize your measurement units, select the **Profile** icon  in the top left corner of the application.

Scroll to the **General** section of the **Profile**, and select the **Units** tab. Customize your map units, this will apply to all downloaded maps. Feel free to customize any other settings found under your **Profile**, these settings will be saved even without an account, unless the application data is completely erased from the device.
