## **SPRING ARCHERY TURKEY**

There were 4,011 resident and 757 nonresident licenses sold for a total of 4,768 licensed spring archery turkey hunters in 2025.

Surveys were sent via email invitations to respond online. All license holders that provided a valid email address were surveyed, and 1,949 responses were received for a rate of 41%.

The projected harvest based on survey responses was 1,438 male turkeys for a success rate of 30%. The season was open from April 12 through May 31, except in the Black Hills unit which was open April 26 through May 31. The projected total number of days hunted was 15,814, an average of 3.32 days per hunter.

The five units with the highest reported harvest were Minnehaha, Gregory, Black Hills, Marshall/Roberts, and Yankton.
