With 49 camping sites, 3 cabins, 2.5 miles of paved trail, over 6 miles of dirt/grass trails, disc golf, archery, dog training area, 2 canoe lunches, horse trail, 1869 homestead cabin and suspension bridge. Along with all of these fun activities with 2.5 miles of the Big Sioux river running through the park it gives great fishing and bird watching opportunities.

Disc Golf

Big Sioux has an 18 hole disc golf course. Each fairway has 2 basket locations that are changed periodically. The course runs along the river with many beautiful wooded fairways. The local disc golf association holds tournaments each year, including the Ice Bowl held in February. Maps and score cards are available at the entrance of the course near the picnic shelter.

Did you know?

Big Sioux has a 1869 homestead log cabin, Ole Bergeson built this log house in 1869 out of Cottonwood trees found in the area. They were one of the first settlers in the area and with his wife Bergitta raised a family of 8 in the cabin.

Rules and Regulations

Vehicles / Park Entrance Licenses

- All vehicles must stay on established roads.
- Maximum speed in the park is 15 MPH.
- All motorized vehicles are required to have a valid park entrance license.

ATVs, Scooters and Golf Carts

All vehicles must be road legal and have a valid park entrance license. All operators must be at least 14 years of age and have a valid drivers license. No off-road driving is allowed.

Quiet Hours / Park Curfew — 11:00 pm - 6:00 am

All audio devices and other noises that create an unreasonable disturbance are prohibited. Only registered overnight guests are allowed between 11 p.m. - 6 a.m.

Pets

Pets must be on a leash. All pets (except service animals) are not allowed on designated swim beaches or in any park buildings (including camping cabins, lodges and comfort stations). Owners must clean up after their pets. Please do not leave pets unattended.

Fires / Firewood

- Fires are allowed in designated fireplaces and grills.
- Firewood is available for sale at park entrance.
- Collection of firewood within the park is prohibited.
- Only Certified pest free firewood is allowed into the park.

Littering

- Trash containers are provided throughout the park.
- Cigarette butts are considered litter.

Check-in/Check-out

- **Campsite** check-in/check-out is 4 p.m.
- **Cabin** check-in is 4 p.m. and check-out is 12 noon

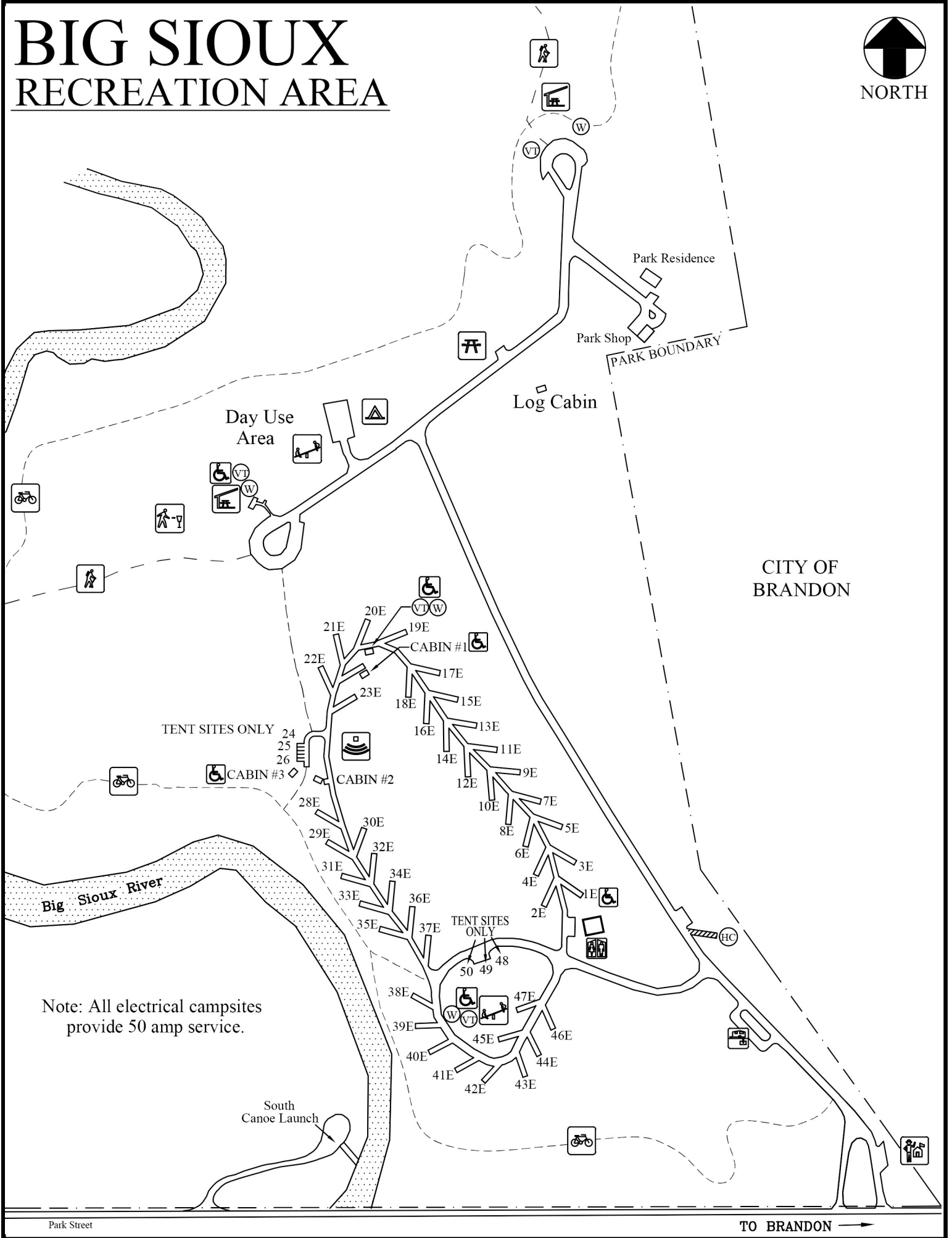
