YOU MUST PROVIDE YOUR OWN HORSE.

IF DRAWN, your role in the roundup will be to assist in gathering and moving the herd several miles. Both horse and rider should be in good physical condition. The terrain that you will encounter will vary from very rocky, steep timbered slopes, possibly up to 50 degrees, to flat prairie. Stream crossings may be encountered. Jumping fallen trees may be necessary. **This is NOT A TRAIL RIDE!**

What to Expect:

The roundup activity for riders will begin on Thursday, September 26, 2024, with check in, safety briefing and orientation ride.

It is **required** that you attend this orientation to introduce your horse to the buffalo, see the lay of the land and learn your duties for Friday's event. The official roundup ride occurs on Friday morning, September 27, 2024.

Due to the growing level of interest in participating in the roundup, successful applicants are not eligible to re-apply for one of the designated public at-large rider spots for three (3) years. This means you will be eligible to apply again in 2028.

This application is for field orientation on Thursday, September 26th, and roundup participation Friday, September 27th. **To ensure a safe event**, *Riders and horses must attend both days*. Please understand you will be an active part of a team that will be riding hard to assist in gathering the buffalo herd into the corrals.
