





FISHING GUIDE TO THE NATIONAL GRASSLANDS





The ponds in this guide are managed cooperatively by South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks and United States Forest Service.

Fishing is a popular pastime in South Dakota enjoyed by many residents and visitors. Many anglers enjoy fishing secluded and peaceful ponds "off the beaten path." Three South Dakota National Grasslands offer this opportunity.

South Dakota's three National Grasslands (Buffalo Gap, Fort Pierre and Grand River) offer anglers unparalleled views, access and fishing. These prairies are home to countless ponds and dams, holding unique opportunities to fish, explore and make memories. These ponds contain a wide array of fish species. Many of these prairie waters are accessible by vehicle and others are only a short hike away. Some ponds offer handicap-accessible fishing piers, restrooms and/or boat ramps, while others offer the simple ingredients for a great fishing experience.

This guide provides anglers with access and fishing opportunity information needed to enjoy what the National Grasslands have to offer.

The ponds in this guide are grouped by each National Grassland and organized alphabetically. South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks (GFP) works to maintain fish populations in these shallow, small water bodies most years. However, populations can still be subject to drought or winter ice conditions. Before you take off on your next National Grassland fishing trip, be sure to contact the local Forest Service office for the most recent information. Other dams and National Grassland ponds may have fish populations but are not included in this guide due to frequent fish kills or lack of data.



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National Forests and Grasslands in South Dakota have Travel Management in effect. If you are planning a trip for recreation please contact the Forest Service office to find out which roads and trails are open for travel and seasonal restrictions. Hard copy versions of the Forest Service's Motor Vehicle Use Maps are free of charge from the local Forest Services offices. Electronic versions can be downloaded from pdf-maps.com/get-pdf-maps. BUFFALO GAP

The Buffalo Gap National Grassland has two districts located in southwestern South Dakota. One is south and northeast of Hot Springs; the other is south and west of Wall. There are few developed recreation sites, but plenty of space for various recreational opportunities.



The National Grassland Visitor Center is located in Wall, South Dakota. This site provides the history behind the system of the National Grasslands located across the West.


FISHING

The ponds on Buffalo Gap National Grassland provide great fishing year-round. There are a number of ponds near Wall.



HIKING AND BIKING

Follow the dirt two-tracks or bike and hike cross-country anywhere on the National Grasslands. "Anywhere" may seem overwhelming, but the National Grasslands are unique and offer new experiences for recreationists. There is one developed trail near Wall, South Dakota. To access this trail, from Interstate 90 take exit 116, go south, cross two auto gates, then park. Wooden 4x4 posts mark this 5 1/2-mile loop trail. There is an extension of this trail to make it a 15-mile loop. The Badlands Wall formation is in view of this trail.






FORT PIERRE

The Fort Pierre National Grassland (FPNG) is comprised of approximately 116,000 acres of federal land located south of Fort Pierre, South Dakota, north of Interstate 90, and west of the Lower Brule Indian Reservation. The topography ranges from flat to gently rolling hills with large drainages on the north and west boundaries. The Fort Pierre National Grassland has intermittent drainages that are dammed to create small ponds providing water for wildlife and livestock. Many of these ponds are important for waterfowl habitat and popular fisheries.





FPNG is known for its mixed grass prairie vegetation that provides shelter to the greater prairie-chicken, the sharp-tailed grouse, the ringnecked pheasant and numerous migrating birds. Other wildlife species make their homes on the Fort Pierre National Grasslands, including: blacktailed prairie dogs, badgers, coyotes, rattlesnakes. burrowing owls, raptors, jackrabbits, mule deer, whitetailed deer and pronghorn.

Fishing is popular on the FPNG due to its variety of fish and access points. Numerous ponds have year-round or seasonal (Dec. 1 - Aug. 31) access roads leading to the water's edge. Anglers who want a more secluded experience can hike a short distance from the road. Forest Service roads open to the public are typically mowed late summer. The FPNG has two undeveloped campgrounds with dams for fishing: Richland Dam and Sheriff Dam.
