

## WHERE THE MONEY GOES

In 2019 the Hunt for Habitat raised a total of \$320,990. GFP initiated over 40 projects in 2019, including high diversity native grass seedings, pollinator plots, and woody cover plantings. Once fully completed in 2020 these projects will improve 30 different Game Production Areas (GPA) in 25 counties on over 1,000 acres.
