

Expanding The Campus: Indoor Space



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Range - Classrooms - Processing

We are expanding! As I know many of you have noticed, our museum area has been closed since COVID started in 2020. We made the decision to close it in 2020 to mitigate spread, later in that year we converted the space into a large classroom space for social distancing. To date, we still have it closed due to our need for a large classroom space for programming.

In the wake of all of this, we are addressing our space need by moving forward with fundraising for an expansion to include more classroom space, an indoor archery/bb gun range, a dedicated game processing space, a meat grilling/smoking deck, an intern work space, a nursing mother's room, and more.

Expanding The Campus: Outdoor Space



60-Yard Outdoor Range

We are also working to expand our outdoor area. Our current archery range is only rated for 30-lb. bows. With the growth seen in the sport of archery and bow hunting, we are working to meet that need. This new space will allow for larger poundage bows and for folks to be able to shoot at longer distances.

As with all we do, safety is key. The range will have a fence to prevent entrance to firing area of the range. Range commanders and cameras will also be employed where appropriate for safety.

On May 10th, SD Game, Fish and Parks partnered with the city of Sioux Falls Fire Rescue to implement a prescribed burn on part of the Campus's natural prairie field. Historically, fire has been a natural part of the prairie landscape. Prescribed burns are utilized to help reset grassland ecosystems to allow native plants to become more dominant over nonnative species.

Saturday, October 1 from 1:00 - 4:00 PM


