How to Enter

1. Pick your favorite three photos to submit
 - a. Check out the categories below to pick your best photos.
 - b. Use the outlined categories to help narrow down your top three photos.
 - c. Don't worry about choosing a category for each photo, the judges will categorize all submitted photos during the selection process.
2. Fill out the submission form at <https://gfp.sd.gov/pages/snapshot-south-dakota/>
 - a. Make sure your contact information is correct so we can contact you if you win!
3. Be sure to share with your friends and "Like" South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks on Facebook to stay updated and keep an eye out for the "People's Choice" photo album that will be uploaded on our page after the contest ends on May 31.
 - a. Once the contest closes, all eligible photos will be uploaded to an album on the GFP Facebook page and the photo with the most likes will win the People's Choice award.

Categories

1. Spring Landscapes
 - a. South Dakota is home to truly gorgeous views! As the grass starts to turn green and flowers begin to bloom the photos you can capture are endless.
2. Spring Fishing
 - a. Spring is one of the best times to hit the water in search of trophy walleyes or some tasty pan fish. We can't wait to see what you catch!
3. Pollinators
 - a. The possibilities are truly endless for this category. Whether it's a photo of a flower, a butterfly or you and your family out planting a garden, this category is for you!

Photos that contain inappropriate imagery, activities, or language will not be eligible. Photos are deemed eligible at the Judges' discretion.

The panel of judges will be made up of GFP staff members.

Judging Decisions

- There will be four winners: People's Choice and the "Category Champions".
- Photos submitted that are deemed appropriate by the judges will be placed in the "People's Choice" photo album on the GFP Facebook page.
 - The photo with the most "Likes" in this album will win the People's Choice award.
 - This photo will be removed from all other categories.



- Judges will categorize all photos into the photo categories.
 - Photographers are not allowed to select which category their photo goes into.

Eligibility

- Snapshot South Dakota is open to both residents and nonresidents.
- Participants are not required to have a hunting, fish or trapping license to enter.
 - A valid park entrance license is required to enter all South Dakota state parks.
- The photo contest is open to all ages.
 - It is encouraged any youth participating use their parent or legal guardian's contact information, to ensure GFP can contact them should they win.
- Photos deemed ineligible by judges will not be shared on any public forum, including the People's Choice Facebook album.
 - Eligibility is at the judge's discretion.
- Photos are not required to have been taken during the time period, but they must be submitted during the set timeframe.
 - April 13 - May 31.
- Photos must have been taken by the original photographer. Photos found to be of someone else's work will automatically be removed.
 - If you wish to submit a photo on someone else's behalf, please use their name in the submission process. If necessary, include your contact info, but credit will be given to the name associated with the photo.

The South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks may use all submitted photos through Snapshot South Dakota on all department platforms, both print and digital, including, but not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, publications and other forms of communication related to the department.

By entering Snapshot South Dakota, you give South Dakota Game, Fish and Parks permission to contact you.
