The Custer State Park Trail Challenge began as a way to invite visitors to hike the trails of Custer State Park and experience a different aspect of the park. We hope you enjoy the Trail Challenge and make wonderful memories along the way!

- The Summer Trail Challenge consists of the eight trails listed above and is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day. (May 28 - Sept. 2, 2018)
- Pick up an official Trail Challenge form at any of the park's visitor centers.
- At one point along each trail is a bronze rubbing medallion installed near a post with a Trail Challenge Sign. To complete the Trail Challenge, participants must hike all the listed trails and collect a rubbing, or photo of themselves at a Trial Challenge rubbing medallion.
- Completed forms with rubbings, or photo verification, can be turned in at the Peter Norbeck Outdoor Education Center, Visitor Center, or Park Office. All completed forms must be submitted by Monday, Sept. 10, 2018.
