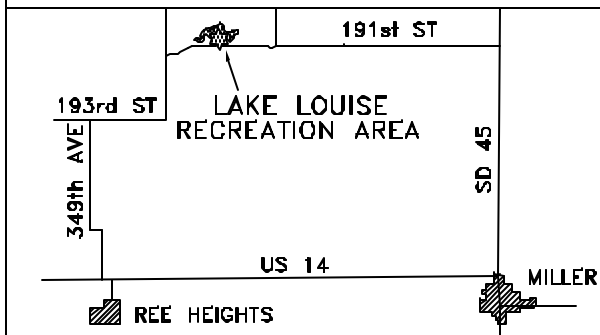
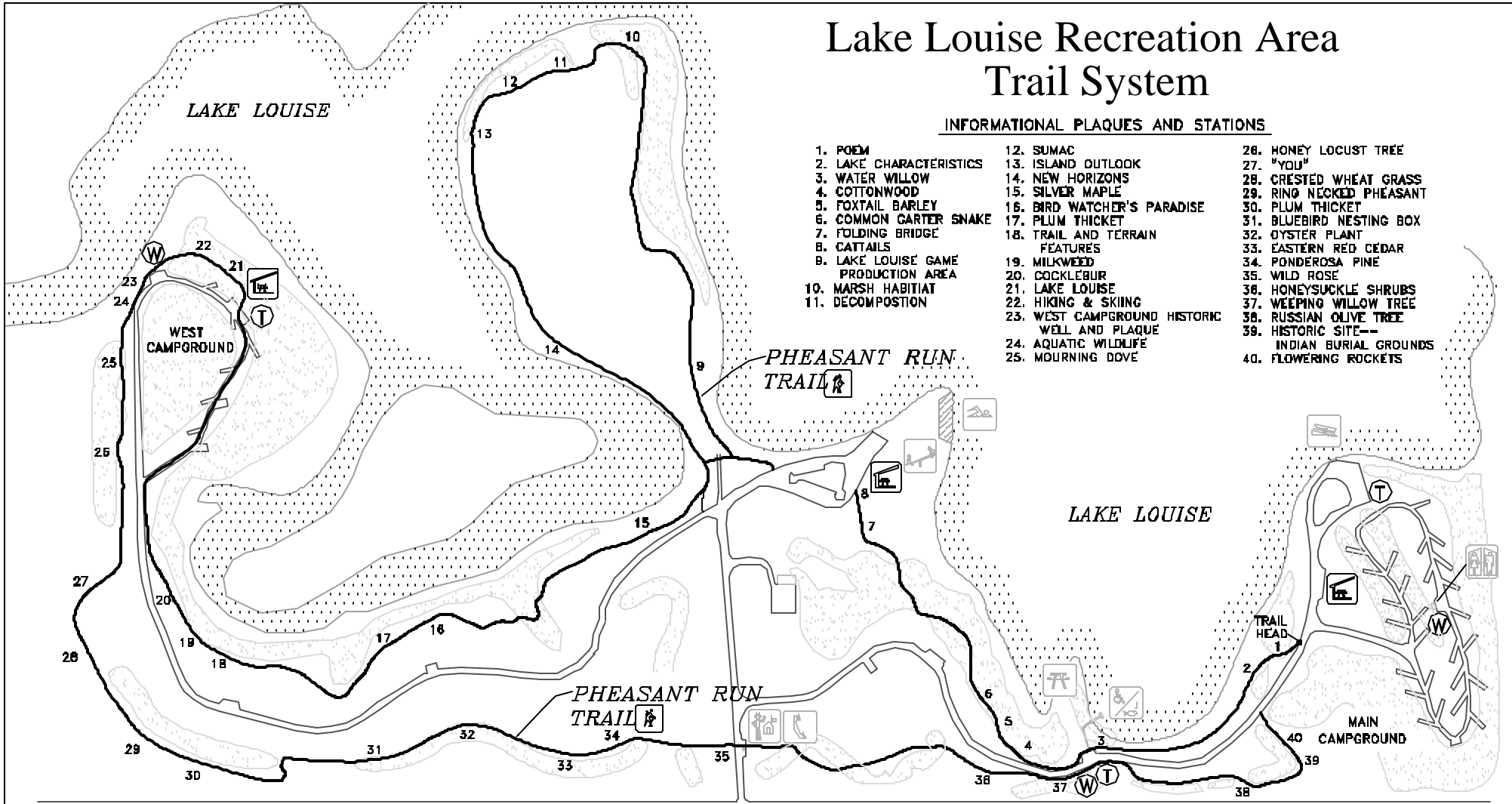

Pheasant Run Trail

Type of trail: Hiking and interpretive/viewing nature

Trail surface: Dirt and grass

Rated: Easy, appropriate for all ages

Fee required: Park Entrance License

Length of trail in miles: 3.2 miles

Location of the trailhead: Near entrance to campground

Facilities at or near the trailhead: Campground

Facilities along the trail: Toilet, drinking water, bench, picnic table, pay phone – trail runs through park
