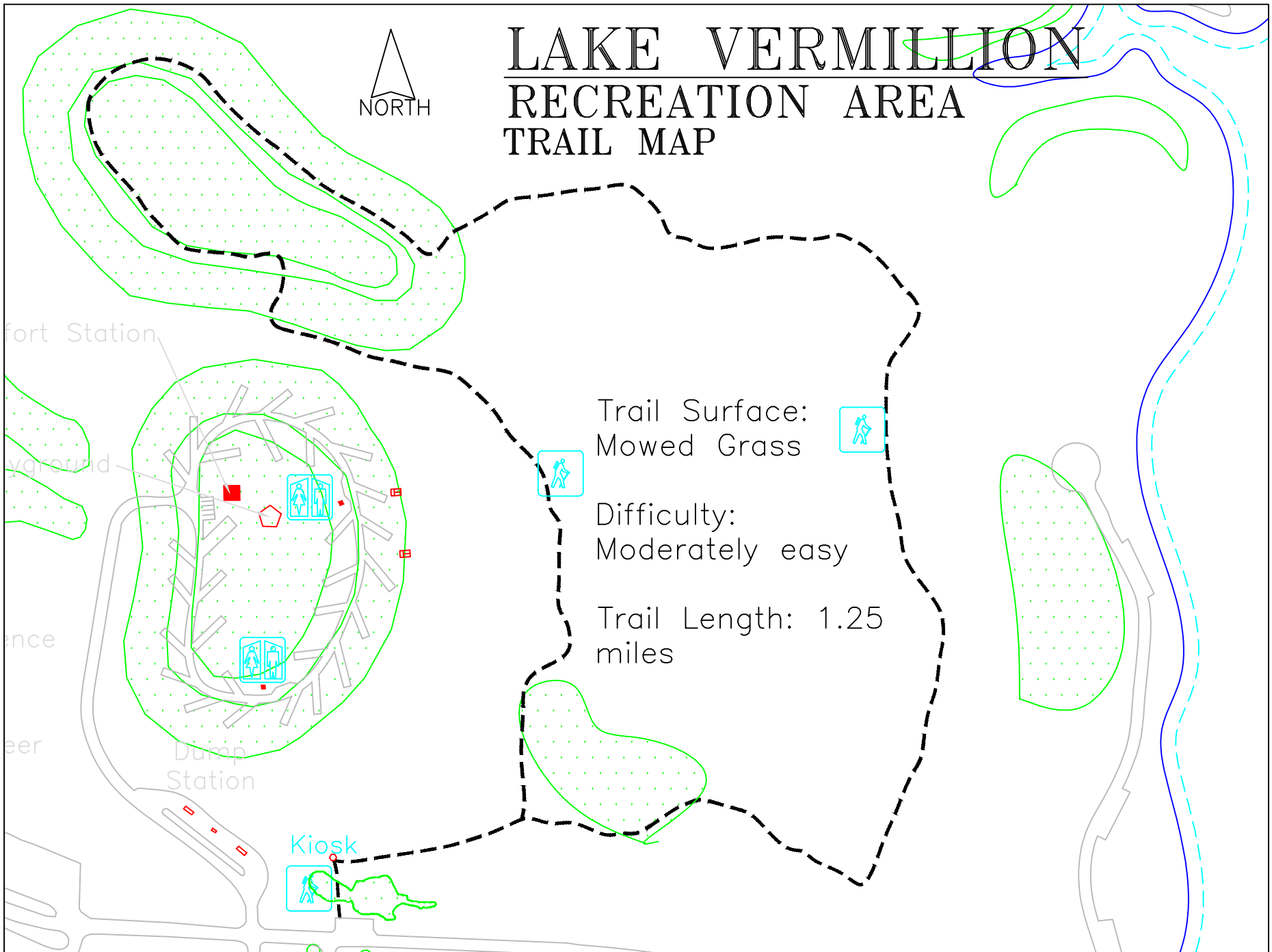

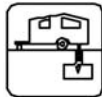

## **Otter Stream Trail**

**Type of trail:** Hiking

**Length of trail:** 1.25 miles

**Trail surface:** Mowed

**Rated:** Easy and appropriate for all ages

**Fee required:** Park Entrance License

**Location of the trailhead:** .25 mile east of the west park entrance

**Facilities at or near the trailhead:** Drinking water, toilet, parking, picnic tables, swim beach, and campground

**Facilities along the trail:** None

**What lodging opportunities are provided IN the park?** Tent camping, electrical and non-electrical campsites, wheelchair accessible campsite, camping cabins

**Nearest facilities for purchasing snacks, sunscreen, etc:** Right on lake just south of park entrance

**Nearest motels/restaurants OUTSIDE the park:**

In Canistota - 7 miles; in Montrose - 7 miles; steakhouse on lake
