# Welcome to Palisades State Park

Palisades State Park is one of the most unique areas in South Dakota. The Split Rock Creek, which flows through the park, is lined with Sioux quartzite formations varying from shelves several feet above the water to 50-foot vertical cliffs. Scenic overlooks, rock climbing, five hiking trails and rushing water make Palisades a popular destination.

## **Rules and Regulations**

#### Jumping / Diving Prohibited

A person may not jump or dive from cliffs, rock formations, or bridges into the waters of Split Rock Creek which lies within the boundaries of Palisades State Park.

Game, Fish & Parks

#### Vehicles / Park Entrance Licenses

- All vehicles must stay on established roads.
- Maximum speed in the park is 15 MPH.
- All motorized vehicles are required to have a valid park entrance license.

#### **ATVs, Scooters and Golf Carts**

All vehicles must be road legal and have a valid park entrance license. All operators must be at least 14 years of age and have a valid drivers license. No off-road driving is allowed.

#### Quiet Hours / Park Curfew — 11 p.m. - 6 a.m.

All audio devices and other noises that create an unreasonable disturbance are prohibited. Only registered overnight guests are allowed between 11 p.m. - 6 a.m.

#### Pets

Pets must be on a leash. Animals (except service animals) are not allowed on designated swim beaches or in any park buildings (including camping cabins, lodges and comfort stations). Owners must clean up after their pets. Please do not leave pets unattended.

#### **Fires / Firewood**

- Only certified wood is permitted into the park.
- Fires are allowed in designated fireplaces and grills.
- Firewood is available for sale at park entrance.
- Collection of firewood within the park is prohibited. Littering
- Trash containers are provided throughout the park.
- Cigarette butts are considered litter.

#### Check-in/Check-out

- **Campsite** check-in/check-out is 4 p.m.
- Cabin check-in is 4 p.m. and check-out is 12 noon
- Lodge check-in is 4 p.m. and check-out is 11 a.m.
