Why sign up for BeEQIP?

1. Create/enhance nesting and brood rearing cover for pheasants and other wildlife
2. Many of the cover crop species allowed under BeEQIP make great food plots for deer and other big game species
3. Many BeEQIP practices provide additional forage for livestock that can be hayed or grazed after the primary bloom period
4. Provides safe foraging areas for our states honeybees!

Primary option on existing cropland – may be grazed after primary bloom

340/645 cover crop and upland wildlife combination (earnings limit per offer)

\$43.66 per year for seeding multiple species

\$140.13 per year includes foregone income and monitoring

May seed 1 time with perennial multi-species mix on same acres or can seed annually up to 3 years

Other options available based on existing land use:

1 time seeding options:

Earnings based on seeding mix – see docket

327/315 – Conservation Cover – pollinator mix

512/511/315 – Forage and Biomass – may be hayed after primary bloom

550/315 – Range Planting - may be grazed after primary bloom

386/315 - Field Border

390/315 – Riparian Herbaceous Cover

All areas must be 125' min. if next to grass areas on one side.

250' min. if cropland on both sides.
